**Subject:- Grant of conditional permission to Gaur Brahmin Ayurvedic College & Hospital, Village & P.O. Brahmanwas, Distt. Rohtak-124001, Haryana (Inst. ID- AYU0038) with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course under section 28 of the NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2022-23 and relevant regulations thereunder in respect of appeal dated 03.11.2022-regarding.**

Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provision of National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-division (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) shall stand dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby notifies that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021.

- This is with reference to the first appeal filed by **Principal, Gaur Brahmin Ayurvedic College & Hospital, Village & P.O. Brahmanwas, Distt. Rohtak-124001, Haryana**. vide letter ref. no. GBAC/22/294-297 dated 29.11.2022 to the commission in respect of denial of conditional permission issued to **Gaur Brahmin Ayurvedic College & Hospital, Village & P.O. Brahmanwas, Distt. Rohtak-124001, Haryana (Inst. ID- AYU0038) for conducting 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course** due to not fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria in terms of Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016" and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder due to non availability of teaching staff as mentioned in denial order dated 23.11.2022.
- Thereafter the said appeal was placed before the Chairman, NCISM and Chairman NCISM constituted a Hearing Committee and provided an opportunity of hearing to the college. Accordingly, the letter was sent to The Principal, Gaur Brahmin Ayurvedic College & Hospital, Village & P.O. Brahmanwas, Distt. Rohtak-124001, Haryana vide commission letter no. **NCISM/Comm./Appeal/(2022-23)(Haryana) dated 30.11.2022** to appear before the designated hearing committee as constituted by the Chairman, NCISM on **01.12.2022** in respect of appeal filed under section 10(1)(g) and section 24(3) of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine ACT, 2020 and to produce all relevant valid documents/records/ proof to substantiate the claims and make written submission and submit an authenticated copy of evidence/verifications to commission with shortcoming wise clarifications mentioned in the denial order dated 23.11.2022 passed by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM. The proceedings of appeal was held virtually on **01.12.2022** and on behalf of Gaur Brahmin Ayurvedic College & Hospital, Village & P.O. Brahmanwas, Distt. Rohtak-124001, Haryana, Dr. Manish Sharma, Principal, attended the hearing, attended the hearing.
- The hearing committee sought clarification from the representatives of Gaur Brahmin Ayurvedic College & Hospital, Haryana regarding shortcomings mentioned in the denial order dated 23.11.2022 passed by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM, which is as under:-

(i) Availability of Total Teaching Staff is 82.60% against the minimum requirement of 90% as required in Schedule-V of MSR-2016.	<p>With due respect, this is to state that Gaur Brahman Ayurvedic College and Hospital is running BAMS course since 1974. Our permission for academic session 2022-23 is denied vide letter no. 26-33/MARB/2022-College dated 23-11-2022 after the hearing held on dated 10-11-2022.</p> <p>It is respectfully submitted that as per point (iv) of Schedule V of MSR-2016, it is require to have- "For example – the college having sixty one to hundred seats intake capacity shall have minimum forty faculties, out of which minimum nineteen professors (or) readers covering all fourteen Departments."</p> <p>It is admitted and on record that we are having 21 higher faculties against requirement of 19 faculties, on the date of inspection even as on today, which squarely makes the institute eligible for intake of 100 seats. Therefore, to hold, vides impugned order dated 23-11-2022, that the institute is running short with 08 higher faculties, is against point (iv) of Schedule V of MSR-2016. It is shocking and unfortunate that despite fulfilling all the requirements as per schedule V of MSR-2016, our institute has been denied conditional permission, is patently illegal and arbitrary.</p> <p>I would also like to bring to your notice that the institute is running since 1974 and getting continuous permissions of 100 UG seats since 2016 on the basis of MSR-2016. Furthermore, without admitting any deficiency of faculty, the institute has advertised for engaging eight (08) higher faculties and its interview process is still going on, which, after appointment, will take the tally of Professors or Readers up to 52 from 44 (existing as on today).</p> <p>Kindly consider the present appeal and grant the permission of UG 100 seats, because the 1stcounselling is already over and 2ndcounselling will be from 01-12-2022 till 05-12-2022. Any further delay in not granting permission shall cause irreparable loss to the institution as well as to the prospective students.</p>



4. The submission made by the Principal, Gaur Brahmin Ayurvedic College & Hospital, Haryana was placed before the designated hearing committee and hearing committee sought clarification in respect of no. of Higher & Lower faculty available in 14 department of college. In response of the same Principal shown the attendance register of 21 Higher faculty and 23 Lower faculty covering all 14 departments.
5. Hence, in view of the submission submitted by the Gaur Brahmin Ayurvedic College & Hospital, Village & P.O. Brahmanwas, Distt. Rohtak-124001, Haryana vide letter no. GBAC/22/298 dated 01.12.2022, the Chairman, NCISM directed the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM vide no. NCISM/Comm./Appeal/(2022-23)(Haryana) dated 05.12.2022 to grant conditional permission to **Gaur Brahmin Ayurvedic College & Hospital, Village & P.O. Brahmanwas, Distt. Rohtak-124001, Haryana (Inst. ID- AYU0038) with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course** under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2022-23.
6. Therefore, it has been decided by the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM to issue conditional permission to **Gaur Brahmin Ayurvedic College & Hospital, Village & P.O. Brahmanwas, Distt. Rohtak-124001, Haryana (Inst. ID- AYU0038) with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course under section 28 of the NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2022-23 on the basis of submission made by the college vide letter no. GBAC/22/298 dated 01.12.2022 and direction of chairman, NCISM** subject to the following condition:-
  - (i) The college shall submit an undertaking in the form of affidavit duly notarized within one month explaining the details of providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, non-teaching staff of the Colleges/Hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.
  - (ii) It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 100 UG (BAMS) seats shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2022-23 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.
  - (iii) It is also informed that determination of fee and all other charges in respect of 50% of seats in private Medical Institutions and deemed to be University should be as per the guidelines issued by NCISM vide ref no. BUSS/Fee/ASU/2022-23 dated 16.09.2022. Fees of the remaining 50% of seats are to be fixed as per the guidelines of Fee Fixation/Regulatory Committee (FRC) of respective State/UT/Deemed to be University.
7. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
8. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
9. The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2022 **and send a compliance report to get permission for the session 2023-24:**
  - i) all the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;
  - ii) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda);
  - iii) all the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in to; and
10. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission from the academic session 2023-24.
